Background

Throughout the years, Galaxy Entertainment Group ("GEG") has actively supported the Macau SAR Government's talent development policies by continually investing in, and launching comprehensive training programs and career development initiatives to support the nurturing of future leaders and local talents.

As GEG continued to develop our Cotai projects and expand our integrated resort footprint in Macau, GEG saw the need to nurture industry professionals that have a solid understanding of exceptional hospitality services principles and relevant business operations knowledge to help us deliver our "World Class, Asian Heart" services.

Hence, under the guidance of the Labour Affairs Bureau of the Macau SAR Government, in April 2023, GEG launched a "GEG Integrated Resort Youth Development Program" ("IR Youth Development Program") to provide 12 months of tailored training and career development opportunities for Macau residents wishing to develop their careers in the integrated resort sector.

Program Innovations

With an aim of fostering employment and upward mobility of local residents whilst facilitating quality development of the tourism sector, the IR Youth Development Program is designed to offer participants with professional knowledge, skills, and valuable work experiences.

Having taken multiple departments over six months to plan and design, the IR Youth Development Program identified local residents interested in advancing their careers in food and beverage, housekeeping and VIP hospitality through two job fairs and external promotional activities. Providing the participants with 300 hours of professional training over a 12-month period, training topics include knowledge of



GEG's Asian Heart service philosophy, hospitality trends and development prospects, and practical knowledge and skills needed for their daily work.

One of the unique aspects of the IR Youth Development Program is that it offers participants with a wide array of professional certification training opportunities. In addition to helping participants gain international accreditation in areas such as wine, tea art, food safety, housekeeping, management and leadership so that they can strengthen their competitive advantage and advance vertically, the IR Youth Development Program also allows them to learn from top industry experts and department heads.

Impact

The IR Youth Development Program started out with an intention of receiving 30 participants. However, due to extensive application and show of interests from Macau residents, GEG increased the intake from 30 participants to 50 participants.

Prior to the IR Youth Development Programs launch in April 2023, GEG and DSAL cohosted a career day that attracted over 100 local residents to apply for the IR Youth Development Program, with over 40 of them having passed the on-site selection. Since the IR Youth Development Program offered participants with a series of professional training, on-the-job training, opportunities to learn from local and overseas institutions, and support on obtaining international qualifications, many local residents found the IR Youth Development Program attractive.

In fact, during the IR Youth Development Program's inauguration ceremony in May 2023, many of the participants shared their experiences and thanked GEG and DSAL for creating the IR Youth Development Program.
